CALL FOR PAPERS

The Digital Legal Lab will host the third edition of its annual conference Digital Legal Talks on 24 November 2022 in Utrecht, in a hybrid format. Please join us and contribute to the program of talks and sessions on law and digital technologies!

THEME OF THE CONFERENCE

The topic of this year's edition of Digital Legal Talks is again dedicated to law and technology. In the context of this general theme, researchers are welcome to address various aspects that correspond to the main lines of research of the Digital Legal Lab. These are:

- » Responsible data sharing and regulation of AI
- » Digitalization of justice systems and dispute resolution
- » Technology for law and legal practice
- » Digital platforms as infrastructures and enforcers of public interests
- » Enforcement and the use of technology (incl. DSA, DMA, AI Act, Data Act)
- » Data protection and cybersecurity
- » Other: contributions targeting other topics in the field of law and technology are also welcome, but may receive less priority depending on the total amount of submissions

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Bringing together scholars of different disciplines covering digit(al)isation of society, we invite both junior and senior researchers to submit published or unpublished papers to present and discuss at the conference. You are also welcome to submit a panel proposal that fits within one of the topics of the conference or do a poster presentation of your research project.

Please submit an extended abstract of your contribution of 1500 words max. to EasyChair. Please indicate clearly to which of the abovementioned lines of research your submission relates and whether you wish to present it as a paper, poster or in a PLSC-style paper discussion or whether it is a proposal for a panel. There are no specific guidelines as regards formatting or referencing style.

The deadline for submission is 18 September and the authors can expect notification of acceptance by 14 October. The submissions will be reviewed in a double-blind review by two reviewers.

We do not require you to submit full papers by the time of the conference, unless you wish to discuss them in a PLSC-style format. In that case, you will need to submit your full paper to EasyChair on 10 November at the latest.
